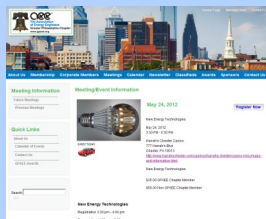

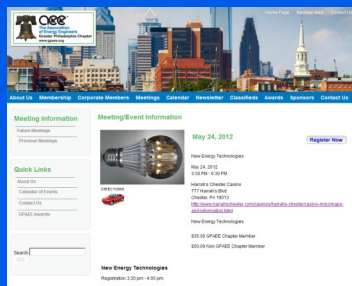

### Electric Ticker Offers Real-Time Power Pricing

A new service that tracks wholesale electricity prices in real time is designed to build consumers' understanding of how power is generated and how it gets to them. The Electricity Price Ticker, launched on April 17 by the grid operator PJM Interconnection and the University of Pennsylvania's Penn Institute for Urban Research, provides pricing updates every five minutes for wholesale electricity in the southeastern Pennsylvania territory covered by PECO.



The initiative is believed to be the first of its kind in the world, and is intended to encourage conservation and energy efficiency by increasing awareness of the electricity market, said Eugenie Birch, co-director of the Institute. ([more](#))

### PPL Electric Utilities Pushing the 'Green Button' for Energy Savings

PPL Electric Utilities customers will soon be able to add an online "Green Button" to the tools and resources that can help them save energy and money. The utility today joined with the Obama administration and electric utilities from across the country to promote the Green Button initiative, an effort to enable people easier, user friendly online access to their energy usage data.

PPL Electric Utilities, in cooperation with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, has committed to joining the nationwide program and expects it will be available to its customers sometime this summer. ([more](#))

### In One of America's Biggest Gas Fields, Law Rollback Could Deter Industry

Rollback Plans to roll back parts of Pennsylvania's controversial new law on natural gas development would make the state less attractive to energy companies seeking to develop the Marcellus Shale, one of America's biggest gas fields, critics say.

Democratic lawmakers in the state House want to remove a measure in Act 13 that restricts the control of municipalities over gas development, and to cancel a section that requires doctors to sign a confidentiality agreement if gas companies disclose the identities of fracking chemicals to them. ### Delta Buys Oil Refinery; Should Others Follow?

Delta Air Lines' purchase of a refinery is being called an audacious defense against spiraling oil prices, but perhaps even bolder action is called for, given the stark U.S. East Coast energy situation. With an even larger refinery for sale just up the river from Delta's new fuels complex, maybe the home heating oil customers of the U.S. Northeast should be pooling their funds together for a bid.

Delta's \$150 million purchase of ConocoPhillips' Trainer, Pennsylvania, refinery, just south of Philadelphia on the Delaware River, gives the airline control over a facility with the capacity to produce more than 20 percent of the jet fuel in the Northeast region. ([more](#))

## ACT 129 UPDATE

### Extension of Pennsylvania Energy Savings Law Under Review

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC) is currently reviewing public comments on the future of Act 129, the state's energy savings law. Phase I of Act 129 requires Pennsylvania electric utilities to reduce their overall electricity load by 1 percent by May 31, 2011 and 3 percent by May 31, 2013, and to reduce peak demand by 4.5 percent by offering electric customers a portfolio of cost-effective energy efficiency and conservation programs. The PUC has the authority to continue Act 129 after May 31, 2013 if it finds that programs have been cost effective to electric customers.

The Act 129 Statewide Evaluator has begun this process by conducting a Baseline Study and a Market Potential Study, both due in early May, detailing the cost effectiveness of the programs. In addition, the PUC issued a [Secretarial Letter](#) on March 1, 2012 requesting comments on various topics pertaining to the future of Act 129 including the calculation of future savings goals, length of future programs, timing, and the continuation of demand response programs, to name a few.

The PUC is expected to issue its Tentative Implementation Order on the next Phase of Act 129 on May 10, 2012.

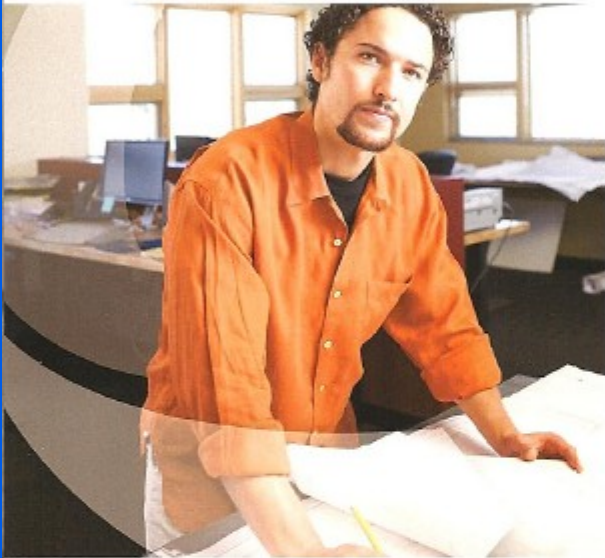
